

Christmas bauble's

Materials:

I used cotton for this pattern and a hook c

skincolor for the heads
yellow for: hair of the angel and the crowns
brown for the ox
lightbrown for the ox
grey for the donkey and cap of the shepperd
white for the cap of baby Jesus and de donkey and the sheep
off white for the sheep
red for the crowns and hat of the king
blue for de caps of Mary and Joseph
yarn in different colors for hair and beards
black for the hair of the donkey

safety eyes for 8 heads 8 mm
black embroidery yarn

abbrivations:

mr= magic ring
sl.st= slip stitch
sc= single crochet
hdc= half double crochet
dc= double crochet
ch= chain
pc.st= popcorn stitch over 4 dc (for more information look at the pattern of the sheep)

all heads are started with a mr. The mr is the bottom of the head. The final round of the head is the round that you will hide under the caps or crowns.

Head:

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]
R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]
R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]
R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]
R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]
R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]
R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]
R8-R14: sc in every sc (7 rounds) [42]
R15: 5 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [36]
R16: 4 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [30]
R17: 3 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [24]
Place the eyes between R 10 and R 11 with 7 stitches in between. Start filling the head and do so till the end.
R18: 2 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [18]
R19: 1 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [12]
R20: dec 1 sc 6x [6]



Close the head by pulling a thread through all the front loops of the last round, close it firmly and cut the thread.

Every head is personal so embroider the way you like it.

Making the caps:

for Mary and the baby Jesus

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]
R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]
R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]
R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]
R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]
R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]
R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]
R8 : 6 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [48]
R9- R 15: 1 sc in every sc (7 rounds) [48]

leave a long thread for sewing the cap on the head.

Place the head with the eyes in front of you and put the cap on from the back of the head. Sew it together (head and cap)

for Joseph and the Shepperd

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]
R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]
R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]
R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]
R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]
R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]
R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]
R8 : 6 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [48]
R9- R 12: 1 sc in every sc (4 rounds) [48]

from here we crochet in rows at the back of the cap.

R13: ch 2, 32 dc, ch 1 (turn)

R14: 33 dc, ch 1 (turn)

R15: 33 dc.

Cut the yarn and hide it. place the hat on top of the head and sew with a different color a line around. Sew the hat and head together.

Hair for the angle

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]
R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]
R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]
R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]
R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]
R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]
R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]

R8 : 6 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [48]
R9- R 12: 1 sc in every sc (4 rounds) [48]
R13: crochet a ch of 8, 1 sc in next, repeat the stitches till the end [48]
leave a long thread for sewing, sew the hair on top of the angle's head.

Crowns for the Kings

Crown 1:

ch 40. close it to a ring with a sl.st

R1: 1 sc in every sc [40]

R2: 1 sc in every sc [40]

R3: start in the 3th stitch of row 2: * 3 dc, 2 ch (1 sc in the 2th ch of the hook), 3 dc (al in one stitch), skip 2 stitches, 1 sl.st, skip 2 stitches * repeat.

Cut the yarn and hide the thread. Sew the crown on the head.

Crown 2:

ch 40. close it to a ring with a sl.st

R1: hdc in every stitch [40]

R2: *1 sc, 3 sc in one, 1 sc, 1 sl.st * repeat 10x [40]

cut the yarn and hide the thread. Put this part aside and make the inner crown.

In red:

R1: 6 sc in a mr [6]

R2: 2 dc in every sc 6x [12]

R3: 2 dc in every dc 12x [24]

R4: 1dc, inc 1 dc, 12x [36]

cut the yarn. Crochet the 2 together with white yarn and 40 sc.

Place the crown and sew it on the head.

Crown 3:

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]

R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]

R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]

R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]

R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]

R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]

R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]

R8 : 6 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [48]

R9- R 13: 1 sc in every sc (5 rounds) [48]

cut the yarn, leave a thread for sewing the crown on the head.

Take in the middle at the front a couple of stitches together and form a diamond with another color.

The sheep

start with off white

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]

R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]

R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]

R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]

R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]

R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]
R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]
R8-R14: 1sc in every sc (7 rounds) [42]

place the eyes between R 10- R 11 with 7 stitches in between
change to white yarn and the popcorn stitch

popcornstitch: work 4 dc stitches in the same stitch. Keep every last stitch of the dc on the hook.

Then pull the thread through all the stitches, thats 1 pc.st

After every pc.st you crocet a sc.

let's go on with the head of the sheep:

R15: 1 pc.st, 1 sc 21x [42]

R16: 5 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [36]

R17: * 1pc.st, 1 sc, (2x), 1 pc.st, dec 1 sc (1x) * 5x [30]

R18: 3 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [24]

R19: 1 pc.st, dec 1 sc 6x [18]

R20: dec 9 sc [9]

cut the yarn and close the head by sewing in all the front loops of the last round.

Ears of the sheep 2x

with off white

ch 5. start in 2th from the hook. 3 sc. 3 sc in last stitch and then on the other side of the stitches go back. 3 sc. Cut the yarn and sew the ears at the side of the head, left and right :)

The Ox

with brown yarn

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]

R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]

R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]

R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]

R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]

R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]

R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]

R8-R14: sc in every sc (7 rounds) [42]

R15: 5 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [36]

R16: 4 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [30]

R17: 3 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [24]

Place the eyes between R 10 and R 11 with 7 stitches in between. Start filling the head and do so till the end.

R18: 2 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [18]

R19: 1 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [12]

R20: dec 1 sc 6x [6]

snout of the Ox:

with light brown

ch 8. start in the 2th of the hook. 6 sc, 3 sc in last stitch, on the other side: 5 sc, 2 in last stitch [16]

R2: 1 sc in every sc [16]

cut the yarn, leave a thread for sewing the snout on the head. Just below the eyes.

Ears of the Ox 2x

ch 5. start in 2th from the hook. 3 sc. 3 sc in last stitch and then on the other side of the stitches go back. 3 sc. Cut the yarn and sew the ears on the head.

The horns of the Ox 2x
with white

R1: 4 sc in mr [4]

R2: 2 sc, incr 1, 2x [6]

R3: incr 1 sc, 5 sc [7]

R4: incr 1 sc, 6 sc [8]

R5-R7: 1sc in every sc (3 rounds) [8]

cut the yarn, leave a thread for sewing the horns on the head. Next to the ears.

Donkey

start with white

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]

R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]

R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]

R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]

R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]

R6 : 4 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [36]

R7 : 5 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [42]

R8-R10: sc in every sc (3 rounds) [42]

cut the yarn and go on with grey

R11-R15: sc in every sc (5 rounds)[42]

R16: 5 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [36]

R17: 4 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [30]

Place the eyes between R 10 and R 11 with 7 stitches in between. Start filling the head and do so till the end.

R18: 3 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [24]

R19: 2 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [18]

R20: 1 sc, dec 1 sc 6x [12]

R21: dec 1 sc 6x [6]

Ears for the Donkey

make two in pink (cut the yarn and hide the thread)

make two in grey do not cut the yarn

ch 11. start in 2th from the hook, 8 sc, 1 hdc, 4 hdc in last stitch, on the other side: 1 hdc, 8 sc. Cut the yarn.

Place the ears together. One pink and one grey. Crochet the ears together with sl.st in grey.

Sew the ears at the side of the head.

Cut some black yarn for hair and sew it on top of the head.

Star 2x

R1 : 6 sc in a mr [6]

R2 : 2 sc in every sc [12]

R3 : 1 sc, incr 1sc 6x [18]

R4 : 2 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [24]

R5 : 3 sc, incr 1 sc 6x [30]

From here we gonna make the 5 points of the star. You will crochet in rows. After every row you make a ch to turn.

Row 1: 6sc, turn [6]

R 2- R3: 6 sc, turn [6]

R4: dec 1, 2 sc, dec 1 [4]

R5-R6: 4 sc [4]

R7: dec 2 [2]

R8: sc in every sc [2]

R9: 2 sc together [1]

repeat this point 4 times. So at the end of the 30 sc you wil have 5 points.

Cut the yarn and sew all the threads away.

Place the stars with the wrong sides together and crochet a row of sc along the whole star.

Keep filling while you crocheting.

Now you are done!

But lets look at the bauble's if nothing is missing:

- Angle: embroidered eyes and yellow hair
- Star: put together and crocheted with a beautiful row of sc along the side.
- Shepperd: hat and beard
- Sheep: embroidered snout and ears at the side of his head.
- Joseph: hat and beard
- Mary: hat
- Baby Jesus: embroidered eyes and a cap
- Ox: ears and horns, 2 stitches on the snout for his nose. Maybe a bit hair on top?
- Donkey: ears and black hair on top. 2 s titches in the white part of his head for the nose.
- King 1: little beard and crown
- King 2: embroidered eyes and a hat with diamond
- King 3: crown with the red inner crown.
